6. Jennifer Elster, “The Retrospective of an Extroverted Recluse: Part One” at J. Elster Gallery

This pop-up show from conceptual New York artist Jennifer Elster, who was once [David Bowie](#)'s stylist, will offer an immersive multi-disciplinary installation. In addition to photography, painting, and works on paper, the exhibition will feature video works that she has collaborated on with her subjects, who include [Yoko Ono](#), Terrence Howard, Alan Cumming, Temple Grandin, Paz de la Huerta, Rufus Wainwright, Will Shortz, and Questlove. Mariko Anraku, lead harpist for the Metropolitan Opera; Trevor Gureckis, a producer on [Kanye West's *The Life of Pablo*](#); and pianist Sugar Vendil will perform live during the opening.
